## LOST IN THE TUBE

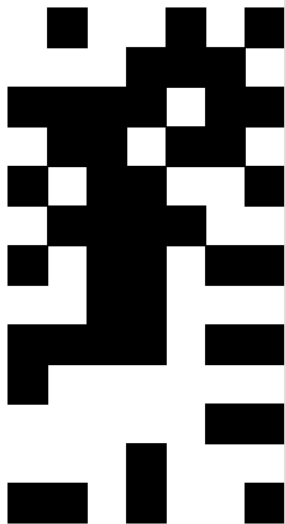
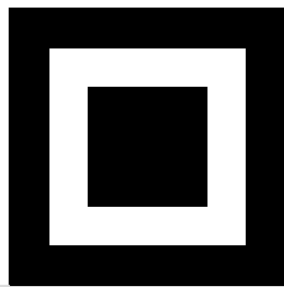
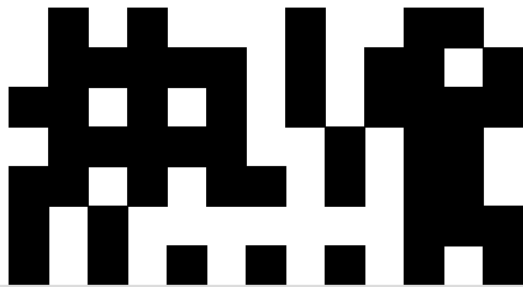
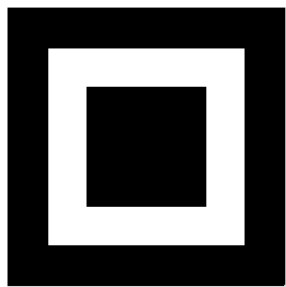
